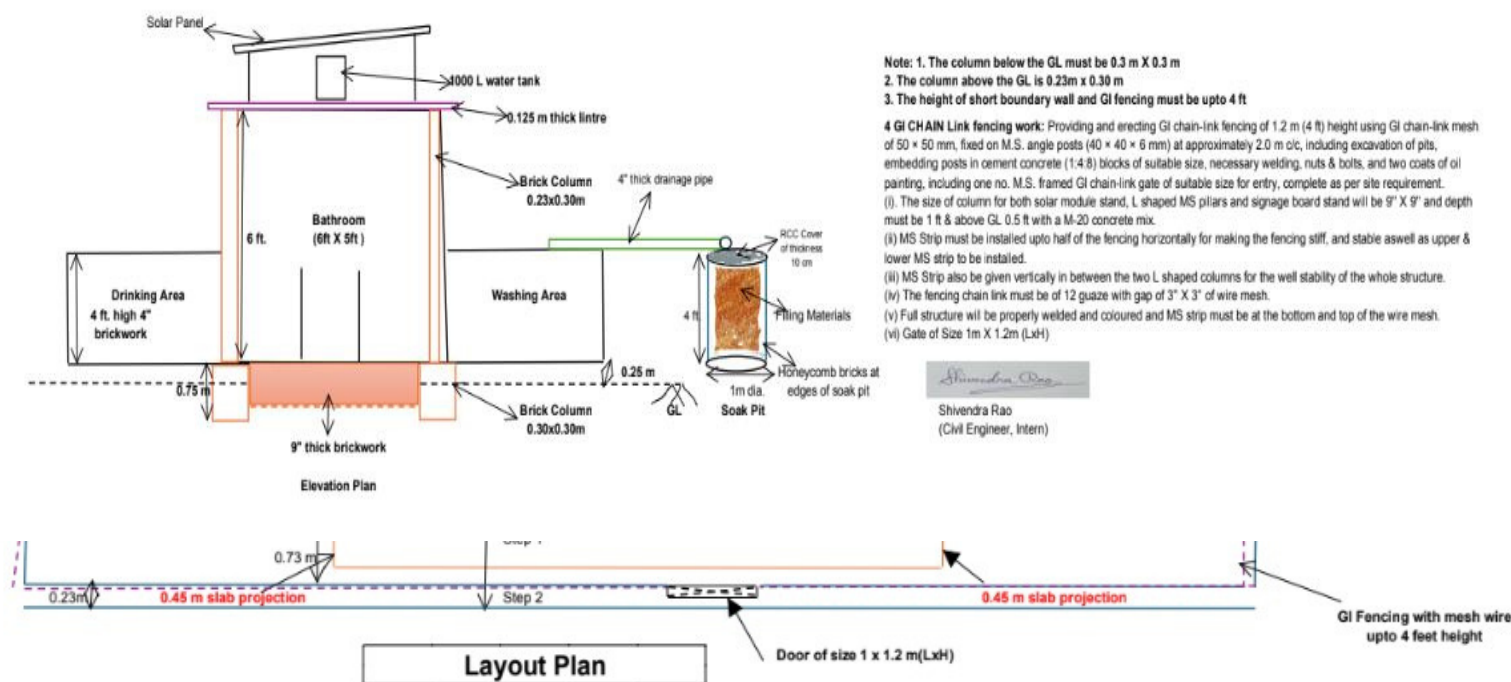

Terms & Conditions:

1. The vendor must have their registration, GST registration and PAN documents. The duly signed copy of each document shall be submitted along with the tender.
2. Earnest Money (2% of Tender value) shall be submitted along with the tender through DD in favour of **"BAIF INSTITUTE FOR SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS AND DEVELOPMENT, UP"** payable in Prayagraj. Tenders will not be accepted without the earnest money. The Earnest Money will be returned to unsuccessful tenderers within a reasonable time.
3. No advance payment shall be made.

4. The 5% of the bill amount (including earnest money) shall be retained as Security money for 18 months against maintenance of the community bathroom, minor repairs, etc.
5. The retained amount shall be refunded without any bank interest after 18 months.
6. **Defect liability period / Maintenance period:** The maintenance period will be 18 months for each unit from the date of satisfactory completion of work. In case defects are found after completion of work, the vendor shall immediately repair the defects free of cost up to 18 months after completion of work. The vendor shall not claim any amount for repair work.
7. **Penalty for delay in completion of work:** The organisation may impose penalties for delay in completion of work except in case of natural calamities and law and order situations. The penalty amount shall be **Rs. 500 per day**. The tenderer must agree to bear the penalty amount for any delay in the completion of work.
8. The rates offered by the Bidder/ Tenderer will be inclusive of all Taxes, License fees, Royalty, Octroi, Labour, Construction Materials, all Tools and Plants, Water, and Power required for satisfactory completion of the work.
9. Any mishap, injury or damage occurring at the site will be the responsibility of the vendor.
10. It should be mentioned clearly that the rates are inclusive or exclusive of GST and the GST rate in % should also be mentioned.
11. The work must be done as per the specifications given in the BOQ. In case specifications are not followed or the quality of work is found to be inferior, the contract shall be cancelled without making any payment.
12. Payments will be made for the actual quantity of work only, which will be measured after satisfactory completion of the work.
13. The authority for the acceptance of the tender will rest with the organisation. It shall not be obligatory on the said authority to accept the lowest tender or any other tender and no tenderer (s) shall demand any explanation for the cause of rejection of his/their tender nor will the organisation undertake to assign reasons for declining to consider or reject any particular tender or tenders.
14. The competent authority of the organisation for the acceptance of the tender reserves the right to divide the tender amongst more than one tenderer, if deemed necessary.
15. The work may not be sub-contracted. The contractor cannot allot the work to any third party. If so, then the work order will be cancelled immediately.
16. All works will be paid based on actual measurements taken at the site by our Engineer after satisfactory work completion.
17. All work should be executed as per the design and drawings, ensuring quality under the supervision of the engineer and not compromising the quality & design of the overall structure.
18. **Quantity Variation:** The quantities mentioned in the tender are indicative. During field execution, quantities may increase or decrease as per actual site requirements in case of civil work/fencing work/ sanitation work/painting work etc. The contractor must execute the work as per the instructions of the field engineer, and payments will be made proportionately based on actual executed quantities.
19. All items supplied must strictly conform to the specified technical specifications for fencing work, tiles, sanitation items, paints etc. and will be inspected and verified by the field engineer before acceptance.
