2- Site Assessment & Pre-Installation Requirements

- A- **Initial Joint Survey:** The vendor must perform a joint site inspection with temple administration before delivery to map out entry pathways, elevator/ramp capacities, and operational zones (marbles, sandstones, high-footfall corridors).
- B- **Power & Water Hookups:** Vendor shall verify 230V/50Hz grounded electrical supply points, battery charging bays, and water filling/drainage points to ensure compatibility before equipment arrival.
- C- **Storage & Staging Area:** Safe, moisture-protected storage and staging space must be identified within the premises for battery charging stations and accessory storage.

3- Quality Check & Receiving Inspection

A. OEM Compliance: All units must be delivered in factory-sealed condition with original manufacturer test certificates, serial numbers, warranty cards, and user manuals.

B. Component Verification: Inspection shall confirm the inclusion of all specialised accessories, including pad drivers, squeegee blades, suction hoses, and fully integrated IntelliDose systems.

C. Physical & Build Check: Inspection for transit damages, liquid leakages (battery acid/oil), structural integrity, and wire insulation integrity before acceptance.

4- Testing, Operation Check & Commissioning

- A. **Functional Run Test:** Mandatory continuous 30-minute operational test for every machine under load conditions (scrubbing, vacuuming, and pressure spraying).
- B. **IntelliDose Calibration:** Verification of exact chemical dilution and flow rates on TASKI Swingo 4000 and 755B ECO units to prevent chemical overconsumption or floor erosion.
- C. **Pressure & Vacuum Integrity:**
a- High-Pressure Jet unit must achieve and hold rated operating pressure without pressure drops or hose leaking.
b-Trooper Duovac 78 wet/dry suction performance and fluid overflow cut-off mechanisms must be verified.
- D. **Battery & BMS Test:** Full charge-discharge cycle check on the TASKI Swingo 755B ECO BMS to confirm battery health and internal charger functions.

5- Post-Installation, Training & Maintenance Terms

- A. **On-Site Operational Training:** Vendor shall provide mandatory hands-on training to designated temple sanitation personnel covering daily operation, safety protocols in crowded areas, chemical dosing, and post-use maintenance.
- B. **Preventive Maintenance & Spares:** Vendor must guarantee local availability of critical wear-and-tear spares (squeegee rubbers, brushes, vacuum filters) and define response times under warranty/AMC clauses.

Comprehensive Warranty Scope:

- **Warranty Period:** The supplier shall provide a full **24-month comprehensive warranty** (or standard OEM warranty, whichever is higher) starting from the date of successful testing, commissioning, and final sign-off by the temple administration.
- **Coverage:** The warranty shall cover repair or replacement of all defective components, electrical parts, motors, pumps, battery management systems (BMS), chargers, and IntelliDose mechanisms at **zero cost** (including spare parts, labour, and transport).
- **Battery Coverage:** Traction and gel batteries supplied with the TASKI Swingo models must carry an explicit performance warranty guaranteeing a minimum capacity retention of 80% over the warranty period.
- **Exclusions:** Normal wear and tear items (e.g., rubber squeegee blades, floor pads/brushes, vacuum hoses, and filter bags) are excluded unless defect is proven to originate from poor material quality or manufacturing faults

Terms & Conditions:

1. The vendor must have their registration, GST registration and PAN documents. The duly signed copy of each document shall be submitted along with the tender.
2. Earnest money (2% of Tender value) shall be submitted along with the tender through DD in favour of **“BAIF INSTITUTE FOR SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS AND DEVELOPMENT, UP”** payable at Prayagraj. Tenders will not be accepted without the earnest money. The Earnest Money will be returned to unsuccessful tenderers within a reasonable time.
3. None of the advance amount shall be given.

4. The 2% earnest money shall be retained as Security money for 26 months against the maintenance of the system.
5. The retained amount shall be refunded without any bank interest after 26 months.
6. **Penalty for delay in completion of work:** The organisation may impose penalties for delay in completion of work except in cases of natural calamities and law and order situations. The penalty

amount shall be **Rs. 100 per day**. The tenderer must agree to bear the penalty amount for any delay in the completion of work.

7. The rates offered by the Bidder/ Tenderer will be inclusive of all Taxes, License fees, Royalty, Octroi, Labour, Transportation, Construction Materials, all Tools and Plants, Water, and Power required for satisfactory completion of the work.
8. In case of any mishap, injury or damage occurring at the site, it will be the responsibility of the vendor.
9. All payments will be made only after satisfactory completion/verification of the work.
10. The authority for the acceptance of the tender will rest with the organisation. It shall not be obligatory on the said authority to accept the lowest tender or any other tender, and no tenderer (s) shall demand any explanation for the cause of rejection of his/their tender, nor will the organisation undertake to assign reasons for declining to consider or reject any particular tender or tenders.
11. The competent authority of the organisation for the acceptance of the tender reserves the right to divide the tender amongst more than one tenderer, if deemed necessary.
12. Quantity Variation for civil work: The quantities mentioned in the tender are indicative. During field execution, quantities may increase or decrease as per actual site requirements. The contractor must execute the work as per the instructions of the field engineer, and payments will be made proportionately based on actual executed/verified quantities.
13. The final payment shall be made after satisfactory completion/physical verification of work on the production of a tax invoice with a warranty card/service card.
14. All items supplied must strictly conform to the specified technical specifications and will be inspected and verified by the field engineer before acceptance.
